Commitment to Safety

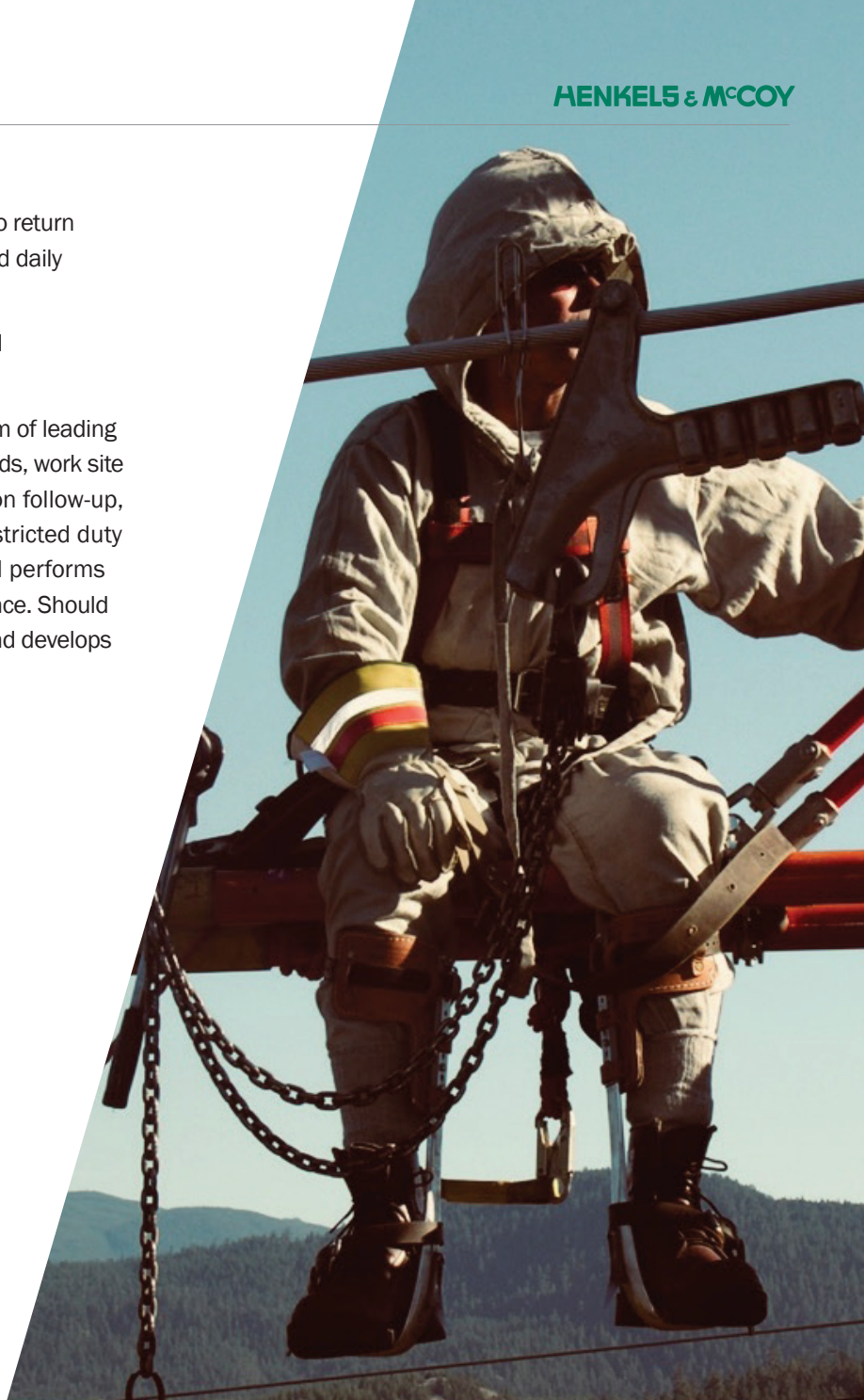
Safety is top priority, and H&M strives for every employee to return home as safely as they arrived to work. It is H&M's goal and daily mission that Nobody Gets Hurt!

Using these indicators, H&M performs trend analyses and program validation of safety performance. Should an incident occur, H&M quickly identifies the root cause and develops corrective practices.
